

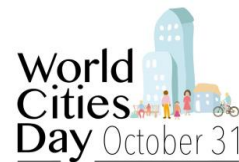

Starts with World Habitat Day, first Monday in October & ends on World Cities Day on 31 October.

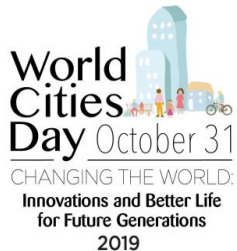
National, regional and local government, NGOs, communities and individuals are encouraged to organize events to promote sustainable urbanization.

World Habitat Day

Since 1985, the United Nations decreed the first Monday of every October as World Habitat Day.

The day focuses on the state of our cities and towns and the basic human right to adequate shelter.

One city hosts the Global Observance, while cities, towns and communities celebrate with parallel activities.

Each year, World Habitat Day has a new theme to promote sustainable urban development policies

In 2018, 80+ cities held events to mark World Habitat Day with the Global Observance in Nairobi.

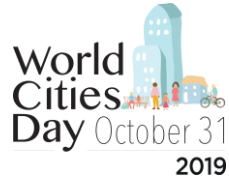

Bahrain: UN-Habitat & Housing Ministry held housing policy seminar

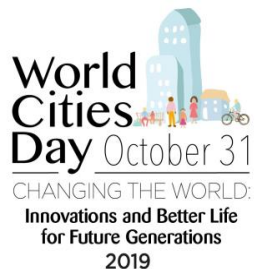
New Delhi: Private sector and UN-Habitat, had an awareness raising for youth on keeping the country clean

Celebrated on the 31 October every year.

Aims to promote international community interest in the New Urban Agenda and enhance cooperation among countries to meet opportunities + challenges of urbanization.

Outcome of Shanghai International Expo. 2010 – UN General Assembly designated World Cities Day (A/RES/68/239).

World Cities Day is an opportunity to discuss how urbanization can achieve global sustainable development.

General theme is *Better City, Better Life* + a yearly sub-theme

The Global Observance 2019 will be held Ekaterinburg, Russian Federation.

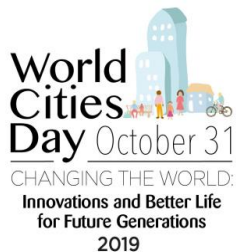
This year theme is: *Changing the World: Innovations and a Better Life for Future Generations.*

Hanoi: Ministry of Natural Resources & UN-Habitat had a climate actions workshop

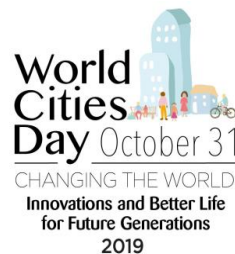

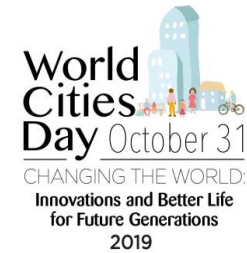
