Join us at 12:30 PM this Monday 1st October to witness statement fashion pieces that provide a reality check on how we manage waste in our homes and communities.

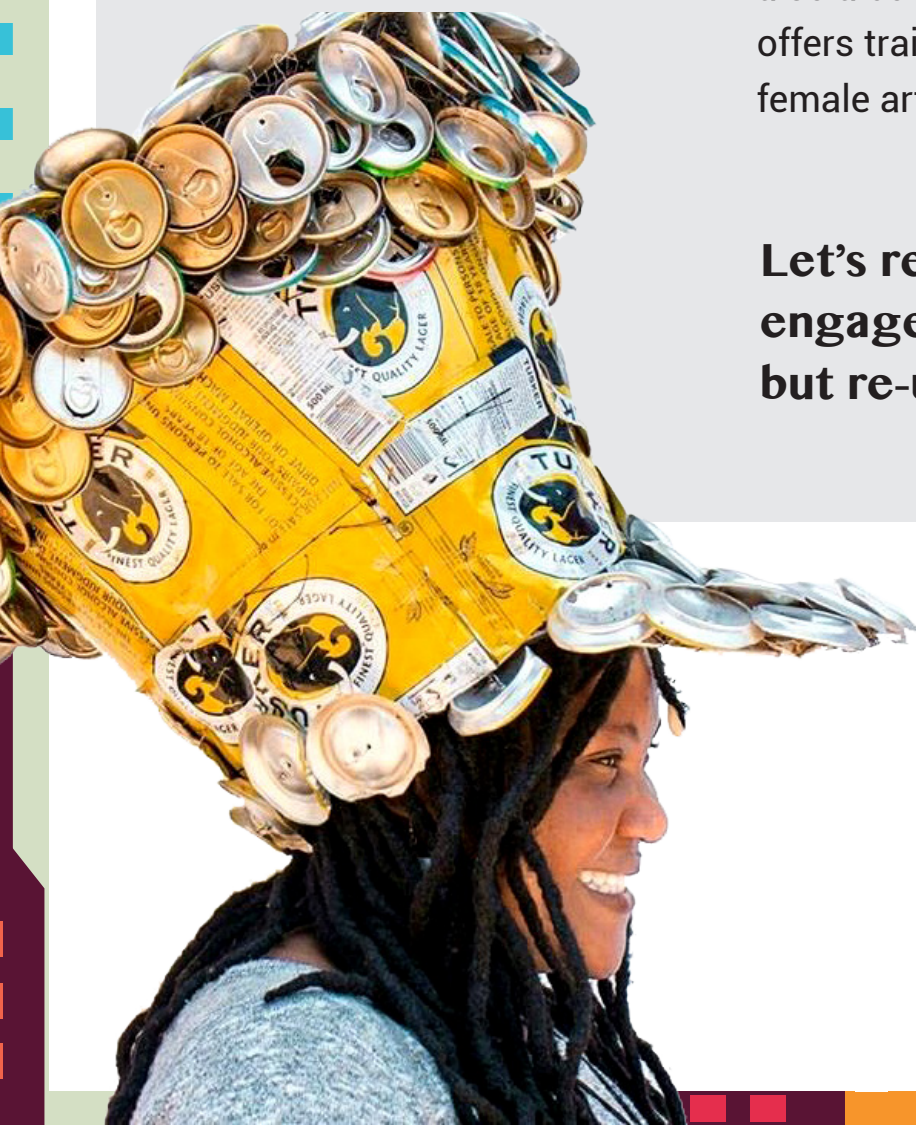
